By fully participating in the program, we demonstrate our appreciation for these gifts and honour the way Christ intends for us to engage with them. 1. The programme is designed to educate the parents and the sponsors. The candidate will be introduced to the ideas. It is the parents' role to cover all the materials with their candidate in their own time and to fulfil all the homework obligations.

2. I agree to be committed to attending all 10 Sessions

Since the program consists of only 10 sessions, missing any sessions is considered incomplete participation. Regardless of the reasons for the absences, parents and their candidates will be offered the opportunity to attend the programme the following year. Unavoidable missed sessions have a homework component, for the parents, of several reflection questions with readings, that will need to be submitted before the next session.

6. Your child needs a 'Practicing Catholic Sponsor' to participate in the programme.

PARENTS CANNOT BE SPONSORS. A 'Practicing Catholic Sponsor' is a person who attends Mass every weekend, goes to Reconciliation every year and receives Holy Communion regularly. They need to be an active member in their parish supporting the needs of the church. Please provide the following:

If you do not have anyone who can fulfil this role, our parish can find someone who will support you and your child. You will need to contact the parish office at least one month in advance to get this arranged. An overseas sponsor is fine so long as the candidate can have regular conversations with that sponsor. We recommend that they complete their journal with their sponsor. If the sponsor is overseas a parent may stand as a proxy at the Confirmation Celebration. Your child is not enrolled in the program without a sponsor.

7. Your email address needs to be working and correctly entered. We send out emails weekly. If you are not receiving emails, it is your responsibility to contact the parish office to correct the information and ensure that the details have been correctly entered. Sessions missed because your email address is not working, cannot be excused.

8. You need to be on the Parish Role to be included in the programme. The Sacramental Programme is coordinated by volunteer parishioners and is parish led. The Enrolment Form for new parishioners is on the Parish Website.

If you are enrolled, you will be receiving regular emails from the parish. If you are not receiving emails, it is most likely because you are not enrolled as a parishioner. Contact the parish office if you need help enrolling.

9. The Sacramental Programme has been developed to catechise parents and sponsors, so that they, in turn, can catechise the candidates until they reach adulthood. The Catechism of the Catholic Church is available online for more information. The programme offers materials and opportunities for discussion with your candidate. Some materials may be too advanced, and it is the role of parents and the child's sponsor to offer that catechism in an appropriate way that reflects the age and stage of the candidate.

The goal of the programme is to catechise parents and bring children to the sacraments with reverence and appreciation for these encounters with Christ that will form the foundational experiences of their faith journey.

10. The Programme follows the restored order of Baptism, Reconciliation, Confirmation then Holy Communion.

- I. All candidates need to be Baptised before enrolment.
- II. All candidates will need to go to reconciliation during this time of preparation. (If the child has made their first Reconciliation they will need to go to reconciliation again as part of this preparation – all Catholics need to go to Reconciliation at least once a year to be considered Catholic)

11. Enrolment forms need to be completed and submitted 2 weeks before the first session.

A parents information evening will be held the Monday after the enrolment has closed. Please do not attend the information evening if you are not enrolled as we will be unable to take new enrolments after this time. Parents may withdraw their child if they find that the programme is not suitable at any time.
